Your card(s) will be placed in your mailbox or if you do not have a mailbox, will be available at Reception.

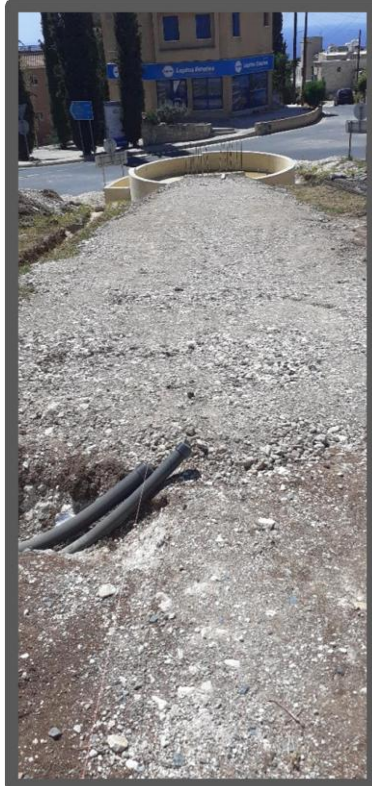

**Please note that non-Kamarens residents can become Associate Members, but cannot vote at meetings. Ask your neighbours and friends whether they would like to join.**

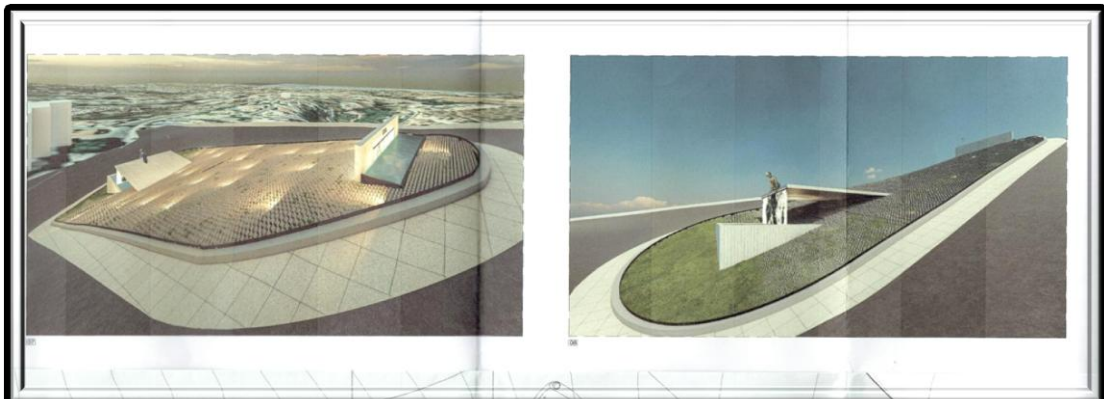

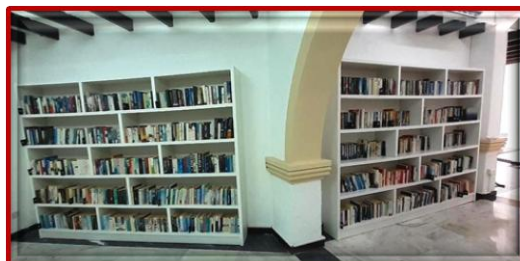

**Dr. Theodora is on duty Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings 10am - 1pm (Non Gesy)**

**Dr. Fotis Vasilliou is on duty Tuesday and Thursday afternoons 2.30pm - 5.30pm (Gesy registered)**

**Dr. Pradeep is available on Tuesday and Thursday mornings 10am - 1pm**

**If you would like to keep a check on your blood sugar levels the medical centre can monitor this for you. Each Saturday morning Nellie one of our nurses will be holding a clinic to monitor this for you. If you wish to partake of this service, please call the medical centre to arrange a time. The medical Centre closes at 1:00p.m. on Saturdays.**

**The following information remains current:**

**The Medical Centre is open from 7:00a.m.–7:00p.m. Monday - Friday.**

**Closed Saturday afternoon from 1:00p.m. and all day Sunday.**

**Appointments should be made for a consultation with the Doctor with exemptions for emergencies.**
