

LIBRARY






Please note - the library will be closed on Wednesday, September 20th due to holidays. Will be open as usual Wednesday, September 27th

Dr. Theodora is on duty Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings 10am - 1pm (Non Gesy)

Dr. Fotis Vasilliou is on duty Tuesday and Thursday afternoons 2.30pm - 5.30pm (Gesy registered)

Dr. Pradeep is available on Tuesday and Thursday mornings 10am - 1pm

If you would like to keep a check on your blood sugar levels the medical centre can monitor this for you. Each Saturday morning Nellie one of our nurses will be holding a clinic to monitor this for you. If you wish to partake of this service, please call the medical centre to arrange a time. The medical Centre closes at 1:00p.m. on Saturdays.

The following information remains current:

The Medical Centre is open from 7:00a.m.-7:00p.m. Monday - Friday.

Closed Saturday afternoon from 1:00p.m. and all day Sunday.

Appointments should be made for a consultation with the Doctor with exemptions for emergencies.
